





Krzysztof Haberko is an emeritus full professor of the AGH University of Science and Technology, Krakow, Poland.

He was born 15-01-1937 in Krakow and studied at the AGH University of Science and Technology and obtained M.S. degree in classical ceramics, then Ph.D. and D.Sc. in materials science.

Professor Krzysztof Haberko has published over 230 papers in International Journals and Proceedings of International Conferences and holds 6 patents. The main points of his interest is related to ceramic powders and nanopowder synthesis, processing, sintering and evolution of ceramic polycrystal microstructure and properties. Under his supervision ten Ph.D. thesis have been prepared and about 60 students received their M.S. degrees.

He is a honorary member of the Polish Ceramic Society and formerly president of this Society from 2001 to 2009. Prof. K.Haberko organized in 2009 the Xth EceRS Conference and Exhibition in Krakow and co-organized conferences of the Polish Ceramic Society

He was a member of the AGH University of Science and Technology Senate and received numerous University awards and awards of the Ministry of Science and Education and award of the Polish Academy of Science. Prof. Haberko was member of the Editorial Board of Ceramics International (1980-2000) and from 2008 till now is member of the Editorial Board of Processing and Application of Ceramics. Numerous opinions on works published in International Journals was prepared by him. Since 1992 he is professional member (Academician) of the World Academy of Ceramics.
