

## CATHERINE ELISSALDE FRANCE



Catherine Elissalde, was born in France in 1968. She obtained her Ph.D in Material Science from University of Bordeaux (1994) and joined Penn State University for one year post-doctoral fellowship with Prof. L.E. Cross in 1995. She is currently senior researcher at the Institute for Condensed Matter Chemistry of Bordeaux (ICMCB-CNRS).

Her research interests lie in the study of structure-microstructure-properties relationships in functional ceramic materials. For fifteen years, she has developed a thematic focused on the design of ferroelectric and dielectric multi-materials at the nano and microscale. She initiated strong interdisciplinary collaborations targeting approaches combining wet chemistry, advanced sintering processes and characterization of the nano/microstructure by 3D imaging techniques. Her current research is dedicated to the understanding of size, strain and interface effects mainly in electroceramics.
