





JOAQUIM M. VIEIRA is Full Professor of the Department of Materials and Ceramic Engineering, since 1999 and Vice-Director of CICECO - Center for Research in Ceramics and Composite Materials from foundation in 2002, both of University of Aveiro, Aveiro, Portugal.

He get the Aggregation (Habilitation) in Materials Science and Engineering, Aveiro University, 1997, and PhD in the Department of Ceramics of Leeds University, England, in 1981, with equivalence to Doctorate by Aveiro University in 1982. He graduated in Physics, Lisbon University, in 1976.

Since the beginning of his academic carrier in 1976 in the Department of Ceramics and Glass Engineering, University of Aveiro he held the following positions in the Department: Full Professor since June 1999, Associate Professor started in 1987, and Auxiliary Professor, in 1982, lecturer as Assistant in 1978 and Training Assistant started in December 1976.

Scientific publications and works authored/co-authored by him include a total 102 scientific papers in SCI journals of principal collection of Web of Science, 1 patent, 3 book chapters and 45 other papers. He has been active in teaching, training and leading research in the domain of ceramics: synthesis, sintering and thin film deposition of oxides, advanced ceramics and composites.

He became member of SPCV-Sociedade Portuguesa da Cerâmica e do Vidro branched to ECERS- European Ceramic Society, since foundation of SPCV in 1981, having been Secretary of Directing Board of SPCV in the two years mandate, 1989-1991. He is President of General Assembly of SPCV at present time.
