







Examples of supportedactivities

Mobility:

Funding of visits by individual researchers to other laboratories within Europe for the purposes of learning new techniques or accessing equipment not available in their own laboratories.

The stays can be from a few days to a few weeks, perhaps of 1 to 3 months or more, if justified by the project.

The grants awarded can include:

- Travel expenses
- Per diem of €50 (for example, if the stay is of 30 days, then €1,500 is allowed)
- €500 per month for the host laboratory (for the use of facilities).




